CURRENT SITUATION

Since August 2016, I have been working on a freelance basis offering bespoke training and consultancy to Local Authorities, small businesses voluntary sector organisations. Projects to date include:

- Delivering training for groups from 6 to 50 on topics including safeguarding (basic and advanced), communication skills, Children's Rights, dealing with difficult situations, 'new to management' and 'management the next steps'. - Both in my paid work and voluntary roles, I work with community members, staff and partners and have developed excellent interpersonal, written and verbal skills to communicate at different levels.
