### EXPERIENCE

- I am an experienced and dynamic leader who has worked both in the statutory and voluntary sector to manage projects from inception to the delivery of challenging targets
- I have in excess of 10 years leadership and management experience
- I have over 20 years experience of safeguarding, including front line delivery and management of services
- My recent work experience is the management of children's services, managing safeguarding through working with families from first point of contact to complex work with Children's Social Care
- With over 20 years' experience of training, I have developed my own programmes in response to identified training needs and delivered accredited courses
- Both in my paid work and voluntary roles, I work with community members, staff and partners and have developed excellent interpersonal, written, and verbal skills to communicate at different levels
- The demands of my roles mean I am extremely organised with excellent time management skills

### ACHIEVEMENTS

- During 2021 – 2022 I expanded my client base to work alongside three Dioceses from the Church of England, the Local Government Association and the Widening Participation Team from the London School of Economics
- Worked with Augmentas Group and Office for National statistics to train team leaders for the 2021 Census
- 98% of 526 learners undertaking compliance training (First Aid, Food Safety and Safeguarding) scored their overall training experience with me at 5/5 (2021 and 2022)
- Pivoted business model to be able to deliver virtual training and also developing blended training options as part to the COVID road to recovery. Worked with over 2000 learners during the year using this flexible approach (2021). Ongoing delivery of virtual training where this meets client demand.
- As part of the response to COVID, I formed part of a strategic team to implement virtual safeguarding training for all volunteer roles within Girlguiding. The percentage of leaders who had completed the relevant training rose from circa 60% to in excess of 90% in six months (2020)
- Successfully secured a volunteer role as National Safeguarding Lead for Girlguiding. In this role, I worked with the volunteer workforce, liaising with paid staff and senior volunteers to support the development of policies and practices, enabling delivery of high-quality experiences for almost half a million girls and young women. - Successfully led group of Children's Centres to 'Good' Ofsted outcome – this is an achievement which only 50% of groups reach <http://nehalifaxchildrenscentres.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2014/02/430088-Calderdale-NE-CC-Group-Published-Report-Feb-2014.pdf>. Strong leadership focusing on staff development was identified as a strength of this inspection (2014)
- Tendered to deliver Children's Centre Services across Calderdale for three years – secured contract value £7 million(2014)
- Piloted and developed the first early intervention board in Calderdale working with schools and health partners

1993 – 2000	Running a registered childminding business (Huddersfield) Out of School Club Co-ordinator (Huddersfield) – this involved setting up a provision managed by a voluntary management committee - which is still offering a service 20 years later. This was in a very deprived area and involved making relationships with local social workers.
